- 1. Demonstrate that the Scout owns their own of, and has used satisfactorily for at least six months, a cycle properly equipped and in good working order. The Scout must be willing to use it in the Queen's service if called upon at any time in case of emergency.
- 2. Demonstrate that the Scout can effect simple repairs which might include the following at the discretion of the Examiner; change tyre and tube, mend a puncture, replace a brake, adjust a wheel bearing or any part of the machine.
- 3. Demonstrate that the Scout knows the Highway Code, traffic signals, lighting-up times, road signs, national system of road numbering and be able to read a road map.
 - Note ~ A Scout who has passed the Cycling Proficiency Test of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents qualifies automatically for Part 3 of this badge.
- 4. Repeat correctly a verbal message after a ride of at least one hour's duration.
